## Residential Programs

### California

- Southern California Edison Residential Heating and Cooling Rebate Program SCE offers a range of rebates to its residential customers, from \$300 for a single stage ducted system, to \$600 for a two-stage ducted system with new pressure relief dampers. For details, visit:

### Colorado

- Xcel offers two options for the purchase a high-efficiency evaporative cooler by offering cash rebates. The first option provides a rebate of \$200 for evaporative coolers with a minimum airflow of 2,500 CFM. The second option provides a rebate of \$500 for more advanced systems that have a media saturation effectiveness of 85% or higher, a remote thermostat control, and periodic purge water control. The SPC incentive rates are \$0.14/kWh for indirect evaporative cooling unit installations (single stage and dual stage) or air conditioning subsystem replacements (including evaporative condensers).
